
To All Snow Plow Operator Permit Holders:

Many Snow Plow Operators continue to plow snow from private driveways or private roadways into and across Village roadways. Such action is in violation of Local Law No. 3-1990 Section 136-5-B: *"It is prohibited to deposit snow or ice on any sidewalk, street, right-of-way or storm drain or to obstruct any drainage course. It is further prohibited to pile or plow snow to a height of three feet or more within ten feet from any corner or intersection of any road or highway. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to employees of the Village of Suffern in the performance of their duty."*

All Permit Holders that continue to violate the above Local Law will be subject to appearance tickets pursuant to Article 150 of the Criminal Procedure Law of the State of New York. In addition, repeat offenders may be subject to permit revocation.
